The Child Brain Injury Trust is a national charity providing information and long term support to families when childhood acquired brain injury strikes.

In the Midlands, the charity has a Child & Family Support Coordinator who works with children and their families in the dark days following their injury when they are admitted into Birmingham Children's Hospital. The demand for the service here is very high and with just one Child and Family Support Co-Ordinator (Sharon Machin), it's a tough job! The charity's specialist team provides non-clinical information and support within hospitals, homes and schools and until the child reaches adulthood. The support provided is varied and depends on the extent of the child's injury, how it affects them and the families' needs, but can include information, emotional support, access to specialist or 'hidden' services, referring parents to a free Benefits Review Service, helping them apply for benefits, advocacy at meetings at schools and with other community or health professionals. Sharon also trains teachers, pupils and family members, provides support at schools and organises family days.

The charity receives no Government funding in England or Wales to fund this vital service and relies entirely on donations. Your support will make a huge difference in the lives of children and families devastated by brain injury
