James qualified as a Chartered Accountant before coming to the Bar and has a particular interest in disputes involving accountants where he acts for both professionals and former clients. Examples of recent work include:

- Representing a major motor manufacturer in a dispute over rust in a car boot, including Case Management Conference and subsequent successful strike-out application. James also successfully represented the manufacturer on the subsequent appeal.
- Advising the shareholders of a company as to the entitlement of the corporate finance advisers to a success fee under a letter of engagement.
- Representing a debtor on a bankruptcy petition based on a statutory demand for a personally guaranteed debt. James secured the dismissal of the petition.
- Advising a franchisee and drafting proceedings in a dispute concerning wasted expenditure and infringement into a geographical franchise area. James then represented the franchisee at a two day trial which resulted in the franchisee obtaining judgment for a substantial sum.
- Representing at trial a consultant in a dispute with his former employers concerning an entitlement to a performance bonus.
