Commercial

Rob Dawson's commercial practice spans a broad range of business disputes, including claims arising from the sale of goods and supply of services, shareholder agreements, misrepresentation, restitution, and consumer credit and consumer rights issues. He is regularly instructed at all stages of litigation and has an active courtroom practice, frequently representing clients at interim hearings involving strike out, summary judgment and set aside applications.

Rob is developing a strong practice in professional liability (see separate tab), and many of his commercial cases involve related issues such as the enforcement of guarantees and indemnities, unpaid debts and questions of contractual interpretation, including the effect of exclusion and limitation clauses. He has appeared in the High Court on multiple occasions to present winding-up petitions and has also appeared before the Court of Public Examination.

Alongside his court work, Rob maintains a substantial advisory and drafting practice. He regularly advises on the prospects of bringing or defending claims, causation and limitation issues, remedies and the assessment of damages. His work often involves providing strategic guidance at the early stages of a dispute in matters involving alleged misrepresentations, shareholder disputes, restitution claims and contractual enforcement.
