His practice encompasses advisory work, drafting, and advocacy in the High Court and County Court. He is instructed by a broad range of clients, including multinational corporations, financial institutions, sporting bodies, insurers, public authorities, and high-net-worth individuals.

Examples of recent work include:

- Successfully represented a chartered surveyor in defending a £200,000 breach of contract claim by his former employers.
- Acted in a £312,000 partnership dispute between partners of a regional law firm, achieving a favourable settlement at mediation.
- Advised the UK's leading minting company on its prospects of pursuing a broker following an insurer's refusal to indemnify losses arising from a fire.
- Successfully represented a client in a £400,000 dispute with his former solicitors over legal fees.
- Advised a local authority on the prospects of a £6 million claim against parent companies arising from the conduct of a negligent subsidiary.

Insolvency

Makhsudul frequently appears in the High Court and County Court in winding-up and bankruptcy proceedings, acting for creditors, debtors, and insolvency practitioners.

He is regularly instructed on a wide range of interlocutory and substantive applications, including:

- Contesting jurisdiction
- Setting aside statutory demands
- Injunctive relief to restrain the presentation or advertisement of winding-up petitions
- Amendment of petitions
- Transfers or adjournments to High Court judges
- Alternative service
- Annulment
- Costs applications on behalf of supporting creditors
- Transactions at an undervalue
- Fixing the basis of liquidator's remuneration
- Restriction on the re-use of company names
- Delivery-up of property

Makhsudul is adept at advising on and drafting opinions in complex, high value insolvency disputes. He is particularly experienced in technically demanding applications under the Insolvency Act.

Examples of recent work include:

- Successfully advising and representing a creditor at a bankruptcy hearing concerning a £323 million debt arising from extensive fraud proceedings against a company director.
- Successfully securing costs for a supporting creditor (formerly the petitioner), following strategic advice to adopt that position in order to obtain a winding-up order against an evasive debtor.
- Obtaining a winding-up order against a property developer after repeated adjournments over a five-month period on technical grounds.
- Advising on the prospects of a winding-up petition based on an intra-company loan of £136,000, while defending a cross-claim exceeding £20 million.
- Successfully obtained a bankruptcy order for a financial institution in the UAE, against an evasive foreign national residing in the UK, on a debt of £631,000.
- Successfully secured a bankruptcy order for a portfolio landlord against an evasive debtor and vexatious litigant over the course of a year-long proceeding.
