## Education Law

Education and public law barrister Faizul Azman has acted for both parents and local authorities across a wide range of education law disputes and public law challenges. A junior barrister, Faizul accepts direct instructions to act on his own and as junior to senior junior barristers at 3PB and other chambers. In education, Faizul has dealt personally with recent School B and F Appeals whilst acting for local authorities.

During his time working with 3PB's highly-respected Education Team, Faizul has been involved and assisted many of our counsel including John Friel on an Appeal in the SEND Tribunal and Emma Waldron with an Appeal to the Upper Tribunal. Faizul has also recently assisted 3PB's Head of Education Law, Charlotte Hadfield, and her junior Matthew Wyard when both were dealing with a dispute before the Court of Appeal which was the first case to consider Section 37 of the Children and Families Act 2014.

Faizul has also become a valued member of the Public Law Team and is one of the counsel that 3PB have had working very closely with Ofsted; and has been instructed to work on three of their present Inquiries into child sexual abuse, namely:
